

School-Based Mental Health Services at Liberty High School

General Info about Hillary's role:

- *School-based mental health services are *completely voluntary* for students, and they are of no cost to students and families
- *School-based mental health treatment is meant to be shorter term therapy (i.e. around 5-6 sessions), but there is a potential for this to be flexible depending on each student's circumstances
- *Hillary can help students find providers in the community if longer term therapy is needed
- *Hillary can also provide students/families other resources in the area (i.e. psychiatrists, eating disorder clinics, etc.)
- *Everything discussed in treatment is confidential between Hillary and the student (Per the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act HIPAA). The exceptions to this are: if the student is a safety risk to him/herself or someone else, or if someone is hurting them in some way.

What to do if you are concerned about your child:

- Speak with their primary doctor about your concerns
- If you, your child, or someone else is in crisis, contact the SUICIDE PREVENTION LINE at 800-273-TALK (8255) or text HOME to 741741 (The Crisis Text Line)
